Entering 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will learn music and choreography to a medley of “Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat”. Performing Arts Camp Junior is for Entering K-entering 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students who will learn music and choreography to a “Little Mermaid” medley. Entering 4<sup>th</sup> grade students MAY choose to participate in the Little Mermaid medley instead of “Joseph...Dreamcoat”, but entering 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students may NOT opt up to the “Joseph” medley, regardless of sibling or friend involvement. If your 4<sup>th</sup> grade student would prefer to stay in Performing Arts Camp Junior (Little Mermaid), please make a note on the registration form.

NOTE: Please be sure to send a healthy snack and water bottle with your child each day for the mid-morning break.

Registrations must be received by **June 25<sup>th</sup>** in order for students to receive a show t-shirt. Students may still register after June 25<sup>th</sup>, but they will likely not receive a show shirt. Price remains the same.
